Draft charter for Transitional Government has been sent to NGOs and additional government officials in Ethiopia

The Ethiopians National Transitional Council (ENTC) is stepping up its campaign to distribute the draft constitution for a transitional government in Ethiopia that will replace the current brutal dictatorship. After releasing the draft interim period charter to the public for discussion last month, ENTC has sent out the same draft to several scholars, prominent individuals, representative of organizations, university instructors and government employees throughout Ethiopia and all over the world.

The draft charter is now at the second step of the charter drafting process. Initially, before releasing it to the public, ENTC has sent it out to several scholars, prominent individuals representative of organizations and has received valuable feedback and recommendations. ENTC will continue to distribute the draft charter to individuals and entities in the coming weeks and months. Comments are coming in and will be compiled for the convention which will be held at a later date with stakeholders.

As mounting evidences have shown over the past two decades, Ethiopia does not have a legitimate government that represent the country's interests and the people's rights. It is thus necessary that patriotic Ethiopians get together and come up with an alternative. That is what ENTC is trying to achieve in collaboration with others.

ENTC was established in July 2012 with the goal of facilitating the establishment of a transitional government in Ethiopia. ENTC took its first major step a year later in July 2013 by organizing a consultative conference on replacing the corrupt, brutal dictatorship in Ethiopia and replacing it with an all-inclusive transitional government. The participants of the July 2013 conference agreed to start the process of drafting an interim period charter. The ENTC leadership has worked hard on coming up with the first draft after consulting with scholars.
